

A preliminary K-12 proposal . . . Kenmare school board members informally accepted this design proposal to remodel and expand Kenmare High School so all students in the district could be accommodated under one roof. As drawn, the plan would remodel about 3,000 square feet of the current high school building and add about 35,000 square feet of new construction, including an auxiliary gymnasium with seating. However, the design is still being refined as board members and representatives of JLG Architects and Kraus-Anderson Construction discuss the school district's needs and growth.
